WHEREAS the Municipality of Bury has requested, in this regard, through the electronic system "Service for the adjudication and publication of the results of debt securities issued for the purposes of municipal financing", tenders for the sale of an issue of notes, dated February 15, 2023, in the amount of \$325,000;

WHEREAS THAT following the public call for tenders for the sale of the issue referred to above, the *Ministère des Finances* received three compliant tenders, all in accordance with section 555 of the Cities and Towns Act (CQLR, chapter C 19) or article 1066 of the Municipal Code of Québec (CQLR, chapter C 27.1) and the resolution adopted under this article.

WHEREAS in accordance with the 1st paragraph of section 2 of the Act respecting municipal debts and loans (CQLR, chapter D 7), for the purposes of this loan and for loan by-law number 441 2022, the Municipality of Bury wishes to carry out the loan for a shorter term than that originally set in these regulations;

THEREFORE.

IT IS PROPOSED BY Councillor Samantha Hartwell, SECONDED BY Councillor Alain Villemure.

AND CARRIED THAT that the loan bylaw indicated in the 1st paragraph of the preamble be financed by notes, in accordance with the following

- 1. The notes will be dated February 15, 2023;
- 2. Interest will be payable semi-annually, on February 15 and August 15 of each year;
- 3. The tickets will be signed by the mayor and the clerk-treasurer;
- 4. the Notes, as to capital, will be redeemed as follows:

2028.	8 400 \$	(to pay in 2028)

THAT, with respect to the annual capital amortizations scheduled for 2029 and following years, the term provided for in loan bylaw number 441 2022 be shorter than that originally set, i.e. for a term of five (5) years (from February 15, 2023), instead of the term prescribed for the said amortizations, each subsequent issue having to be for the balance or part of the balance due on the loan;

4. Water tankers for the rehabilitation of well number 1

WHEREAS we must proceed with the rehabilitation of well number1, to so as to ensure the water supply of network users;

WHEREAS during this intervention, water from the wells cannot be used;

WHEREAS it is necessary to purchase water tanks in order to compensate for the average consumption of 140 m3/day;

THEREFORE,

IT IS PROPOSED BY Councillor Corey Strapps, SECONDED BY Councillor Alain Villemure,

AND CARRIED TO authorize the purchase of water tankers for an estimated amount of \$23,000, plus taxes.

THAT a special tax will be imposed on each unit served following the adoption of a bylaw.
