1. Opening of the Extraordinary meeting

2. Adoption of first draft bylaw number 442-2023 "bylaw on building demolition"

WHEREAS the territory of the municipality includes a built environment whose protection and enhancement of the most significant elements require special attention;

WHEREAS under section 148.0.2 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (RLRQ c. A-19.1), the municipality is required to adopt and maintain in force a bylaw relating to the demolition building on its territory;

WHEREAS the Act to amend the Cultural Heritage Act and other legislative provisions (Bill 69) came into force on April 1, 2021;

WHEREAS article 137 of this law requires the adoption by the municipality of a bylaw relating to the demolition of buildings, including heritage buildings as defined in article 148.0.1 of the Act respecting the development and urban planning, no later than April 1, 2023;

WHEREAS a notice of motion was given in accordance with article 445 of the Municipal Code (chapter C-27.1) and a draft bylaw was tabled at the Municipal Council meeting of March 6, 2023;

WHEREAS the municipality is governed by the Act respecting land use planning and development and this bylaw is adopted in accordance with the provisions of this law;

3.Adoption of first draft bylaw number 443-2023 "Bylaw on to the maintenance of tertiary treatment systems for disinfection by UV rays"

WHEREAS Article 25.1 of the Municipal Powers Act (L.R.Q. c. C-47.1) provides that any local municipality may, at the expense of the property owner, maintain any wastewater treatment system of an isolated residence as per stated in the Regulation respecting waste water disposal systems for isolated dwellings (R.R.Q. c. Q-2, r. 22) or bring it into conformity with this regulation;

WHEREAS the Municipality is responsible for applying the Regulation respecting the disposal and treatment of wastewater from isolated dwellings (R.R.Q., c. Q-2, r. 22); hereinafter referred to as "the Regulation";

WHEREAS under the terms of the second paragraph of section 87.14.1 of the Regulation, a local municipality must, when it allows the installation on its territory of tertiary treatment systems with disinfection by UV rays, carry out the maintenance of such systems;

WHEREAS article 95 of the Municipal Powers Act which provides that "any local municipality may install on a building any equipment or device or do any work necessary for the exercise of its powers" and that for these purposes, "the employees of the Municipality or the persons it authorizes may enter or circulate on any building at any reasonable time";

WHEREAS the Municipality agrees to take charge of the maintenance of tertiary treatment systems with disinfection by UV rays on its territory from the coming into force of this bylaw, and this, in accordance with the requirements of the Bylaw;

WHEREAS the Municipality must also take the necessary means to put an end to the nuisances and the causes of insalubrity in accordance with article 3 of the Bylaw and the Municipal Powers Act, the Municipality will also take charge of the system already installed before the entry into force of this regulation;

WHEREAS under article 244.1 and following of the Act respecting municipal taxation (R.S.Q. c. F-2.1) the Municipality may, by bylaw, provide that all or part of the services it offers be financed by means of a fee structure;
