WHEREAS the Bury Historical and Heritage Society (SHPB) will be responsible for the renovation costs conditional on obtaining a grant;

WHEREAS the Bury Historical and Heritage Society (SHPB) will have a heat pump installed, so heating costs will be lower. Part of the electricity costs should be paid by the municipality because it already does so for the
